It is situated in the Campus of the Sacred Heart Hospital which is spread out in an area of 35 acres of land. In a natural environment, the College and the Hospital are situated by the side of Karaikkal Main Road, in Muthaiapillaimandapam, Kumbakonam Taluk, Tanjore District., Tamilnadu.

MODE OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:

- The Candidate will be notified about the personal interview.
- At the time of interview the candidate should have her secondary school leaving certificate, the mark list of the qualifying examination, TC, issued by the institution last attended, and all other necessary certificates in original and the physical fitness certificate from an authorized medical officer.
- At the time of admission, the candidates who have passed any qualifying examination other than the higher secondary course examination conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu should submit the eligibility certificate of timed from the Tamilnadu. Dr.M.G.R.Medical University, NO.69.Annasalai, Guindy, Chennai-600032 by remitting the prescribed fee with the application form which shall be downloaded from the University. Website.(www.tnmgrmu.ac.in)

ADMISSION CRETERIA FOR B.SC NURSING

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR B.SC NURSING ADMISSION

- Candidates belonging to all categories for admission to the B.Sc., Degree course in Nursing (Basic) should have passed the qualifying examinations (Academic Stream) after period of 12 years of study with the following subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology.
- Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit to the Principal of the institution a certificate of medical fitness from an authorized medical officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course.

- The minimum educational requirements shall be passing of Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course) (Or)
- Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), pre-degree Examinations 10+2)
(Or)
- An equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized Board or University with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum 45% aggregate marks (PCBE); for SC/ST candidates – the minimum percentage of marks is 40%.

2. AGE LIMIT FOR ADMISSION:

A candidate should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or would complete the said age on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the B.Sc. (Nursing) degree course.

3. ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:

The candidate who has passed any qualifying examinations other than the Higher Secondary Course Examination conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu, before seeking admission to any one of the affiliated institutions shall obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the University by remitting the prescribed fees along with application form which shall be downloaded from the University website. (www.tnmmu.ac.in)

4. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of certified study for the B.Sc. Degree course in Nursing (Basic) shall extend over a period of four academic years including integrated practice (Internship 24 weeks).

5. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

English shall be the Medium of instruction for all the subjects of study and for examinations of the Bachelor of Science Degree Course in Nursing (Basic).

6. WORKING DAYS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR:

Each academic year shall consist of not less than 270 working days.

**7. ATTENDANCE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION
TO EXAMINATION:**

- (a) No candidate shall be permitted to appear in any one of the parts of B.Sc. in Nursing Degree course (Basic) Examinations unless he/she has attended the course in the subject for the prescribed period in institution produce the necessary certificate of study attendance, satisfactory conduct and progress from the Head of the institution.
- (b) A candidate is required to put in a minimum of 90% of attendance in both theory and practical separately in each subject before admission to the examinations.
- (c) A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of Degree.

8. VACATION:

The Heads of Institutions shall declare 6 weeks of vacation in an academic year to the students as per the university norms. The period(s) of vacation can be decided by the Head of the Institution.

ADMISSION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DGNM

- 1. Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:
 - +2 passed and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government.
 - 10+2 having 40% of marks in any group
 - Students shall be medically fit.
- 5. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years completed at the time of admission. The upper age limit is 35 yrs.
Duration: Course duration = 3 Years

7. ATTENDANCE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION:

- (a) A candidate is required to put in a minimum of 90% of attendance in both theory and practical separately in each subject before admission to the examinations.
- (c) A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of Degree.

VACATION:

The period(s) of vacation can be decided by the Head of the Institution.

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR POST BASIC B.SC NURSING

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR POST BASIC B.SC NURSING ADMISSION

- Candidates belonging to all categories for admission to the course of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing
- Should have qualified in Diploma in Nursing and be a registered Nurse and Midwife in the Tamil Nadu Nursing Council or any other State Nursing Council also register in the Tamil Nadu Nursing Council accepted by the authority of this University.
- After GNM with the Registration certificate from the State Nursing Council, the candidate can be permitted to join in Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with 1 year work experience.
- If the registration certificate cannot be obtained immediately, the original evidence for registration in the form of receipt or any other authenticated document from the office of the State Nursing Council will be acceptable in lieu of the Registration Certificate.
- Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit to the Principal of the institution a certificate of medical Fitness from an authorized medical officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course.

3. ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:

Candidates before seeking admission to any one of the affiliated Nursing colleges shall obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the University by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application form.

6. DURATION OF THE COURSE

The duration of certified study for the Post Basic B.Sc. Degree course in Nursing shall extend over a period of two academic years.

7. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTIONS

English shall be the Medium of Instruction for all the Subjects of study and for examinations of the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

8. WORKING DAYS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR

Each academic year shall consist of not less than 270 working days.

9. VACATION

The Heads of Institutions shall declare 4 weeks of vacation in an academic year to the students. The period(s) of vacation can be decided by the Head of the Institution.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR M.SC NURSING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of : B.Sc. Nursing Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
2. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
3. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
4. Candidate shall be medically fit.
7. 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.

DURATION

Duration of the course is 2 years for M.Sc. (N)

VACATION:

The Heads of Institutions shall declare 4 weeks of vacation in an academic year to the students. The period(s) of vacation can be decided by the Head of the Institution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS - COLLEGE

1. Students are expected to be regular and punctual at Lectures, Demonstrations, seminars, Practicals, field works and other academic exercises. It is required to attend all allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects.

2. Students whose attendance or progress is not satisfactory, they will not be allowed to appear for the University examinations.
3. Attendance at courses in Medical ethics, Rural orientation Programme and Behavioral Sciences arranged by the College is compulsory. In case of non-attendance of classes, get permission from the Principal for leave or absence with the reasons.
4. Membership in the recognized Student Nurses' Association is compulsory.
5. Christian students are to attend the prayer services and Liturgical activities regularly conducted in the Church.
6. Students must be neat and tidy in their dress, avoid expensive clothes and exaggerated fashions and other costumes. The students should come to the College with proper uniform and well groomed hair.
7. Students have to carry their identity cards certified up-to-date at all times.
9. In the Hospitals, the Students should use their uniform & ID according to Nursing ethics.
10. The students should not take leave for their personal reasons. However, leave can be granted for as per policy and in medical emergency.
11. The students should be careful in handling lab articles. If any mishandling or breakage occurs, the students should pay for the damage.
12. The Fees to be paid as per the stipulated period.
13. Mobile phone use is banned in the college and hostel premises.
14. Ragging will result in expulsion from the college and hostel as per the supreme court direction of October 2007.
15. Parents and relatives are not allowed to see the students in clinical areas.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE HOSTEL

1. The residents are expected to be in the hostel all the time except class hours, library work and clinical postings.
2. The gate will be locked by 9.00 p.m.
3. The General Warden will be available from morning 8.00 a.m.to 6.00 p.m.The students should resort to their tutor-warden for their ordinary needs or for making complaints.
4. The students are expected to keep their rooms neat and tidy.
5. The Hostellers are not allowed to change their room or move furniture without permission of the Warden.

6. If anything is damaged or lost in the room, the just compensation is to be paid by the occupant.
7. The management is not responsible for any loss of goods. The residents are advised to keep their goods safe.
8. The Hostellers are expected to keep the toilets and other common place neat and clean. Water taps should be turned off and the lights should be put off when they are not in use. They are not to throw any thing in the toilet or anywhere in the campus. The waste things should be put in the dust bin.
9. If they are sick they have to inform their Tutor-warden.
10. If there is any change of address, phone number of their parents/ guardians, it must be informed to the Warden immediately. If the management observes that a resident does not follow the rules and regulations, the management may ask her to vacate the room.
11. If any disciplinary action is to be taken regarding the conduct and character of any resident, the management decides accordingly.
12. Each student will be given a copy of the Rules and Regulations and they are expected to sign the document and follow them accordingly.
13. The Catholics have to attend the Holy Mass here in our Chapel and if possible take part in other Church Activities.
14. The management has the right to amend, add or delete any of the above Rules and Regulations as and when it is needed.
15. Mobile phone and laptop use is banned in the college and hostel premises.
